

# Your Privacy on Simulcation

## A quick guide for students

---

Simulcation is a tool for learning how datacenters work — you get to design and run your own simulations. This is a short, plain-language guide to how we look after your information. The full details are in our Privacy Notice.

### 1. What information do we collect?

Your **account details** (like your name, email and username), the **datacenters and projects you build** in the simulation, and some **basic technical information** (like which features you use and what device or browser you're on) so everything works properly.

### 2. Why do we collect it?

So you can sign in, save your work and use the simulation — and so we can keep the platform safe and running well.

### 3. Who can see it?

Your school and teachers, who set up your access. We also use a small number of trusted companies that help us run the platform (for example for hosting and sign-in), and they may only use your information to do that job.

**We do not sell your information, and we don't show you ads or send you marketing.**

### 4. How long do we keep it?

While you have an account. After your account is closed, we delete your information — usually within 90 days.

### 5. What are your rights?

You can ask to see the information we have about you, fix it if it's wrong, or have it deleted. If you're not sure how, ask a parent, guardian or teacher — they can contact us for you.
